

# Snow Rugby 2010 Tournament Structure Men:

**Men** will play in 3 round robin pools; four or three teams in each:

Pool MA	Pool MB	Pool MC
HRC 3	HRC 1	Eagles RFC
JRC	OYUS Rugby	HRC 2
S.P.U.M.I.A.R	Rauma IP	Warriors RC
Vaasa RC	TRC	

## SCORING:

3 points for a win, 1 for a draw, 0 for a loss. If two teams are tied for a place after all pool games, the order will be decided as follows:

1. The result between the two teams (i.e. win/loss)
2. The number of wins overall
3. The number of tries scored
4. The number of tries conceded (fewer the better)
5. The number of red cards (fewer the better)
6. The number of yellow cards (fewer the better)
7. The referee will organize a coin toss between the two teams.

After the pool games three best teams from pools A and B and two teams from pool C will advance to the Cup quarter finals:

- MA1 - MC2
- MA2 - MB2
- MC1 - MB3
- MB1 - MA3

Following the semifinals:

- MA1/MC2 - MC1/MB3
- MB1/MA3 - MA2/MB2

And finals:

- MA1/MC2/MC1/MB3 - MB1/MA3/MA2/MB2

The teams, last in their pools, will advance to the Plate round robin:

- A4-B4
- B4-C3
- C3-A4

The plate winner will be determined by points like in the pool games.

## Snow Rugby 2010 Tournament Structure Ladies:

**Ladies** will play in 2 round robin pools; four or three teams in each:

Pool LA	Pool LB
HRC	JRCL Seals
JRCL Penguins	S.P.U.M.I.A.R
TRC Black	TRC Red

### SCORING:

3 points for a win, 1 for a draw, 0 for a loss. If two teams are tied for a place after all pool games, the order will be decided as follows:

1. The result between the two teams (i.e. win/loss)
2. The number of wins overall
3. The number of tries scored
4. The number of tries conceded (fewer the better)
5. The number of red cards (fewer the better)
6. The number of yellow cards (fewer the better)
7. The referee will organize a coin toss between the two teams.

After the pool games two best teams from each pool will advance to the Cup semi finals:

- A1 - B2
- B1 - A2

And final:

- A1/B2 - B1/A2

The last two teams from pool A and the one from pool B, will advance to the Plate round robin:

- A3-B3
- B3-A4

A3-A4 (This game will not be played since the result will be taken from the pool game between the two teams)

The plate winner will be determined by points like in the pool games.
